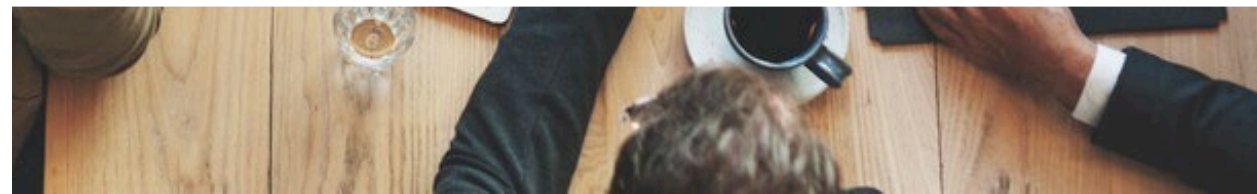

Participation in the Renovate Europe Campaign



Efficient Buildings Europe members are automatically given a **seat on the Steering Group of the Campaign**, working with our national partners across the EU.

Launched in 2011, Renovate Europe is a **political communications campaign** with the ambition to accelerate the **deep energy renovation of buildings in the EU to 3% per year**, through legislation and ambitious renovation programmes. Accelerating the rate of renovation is a key tool in the fight against climate change and will deliver major benefits for people, their quality of life, and the economy.

The Renovate Europe partners include a **wide representation of actors** throughout the buildings sector and have the support of numerous national partners and Members of the European Parliament.

Key Area of Actions for the Campaign

Awareness Raising

- Respected interlocutor at the EU and national level on the energy renovation of the building stock.
- Build knowledge to support policy-making to accelerate the transition to a more energy-efficient built environment.
- Renovate Europe is launching an Educational Buildings Campaign to call for the renovation of all educational buildings in the EU by 2035



Platform for Exchange and Sharing Best Practices


- Targeted forums throughout the year, bringing EU and national experts together
- Manage the Central and Eastern European Energy Efficiency Forum (C4E Forum, which in 2025 brought together 230 participants)

Political Influence

- Addresses targeted communication to the EU institutions and the national level to highlight the extensive benefits of ambitious energy renovation.
- The annual Renovate Europe Day event, held in the EU Member State holding the rotating Presidency of the Council of the EU, attracts high-level speakers to discuss energy renovations.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO BECOME A MEMBER?

Membership Fee

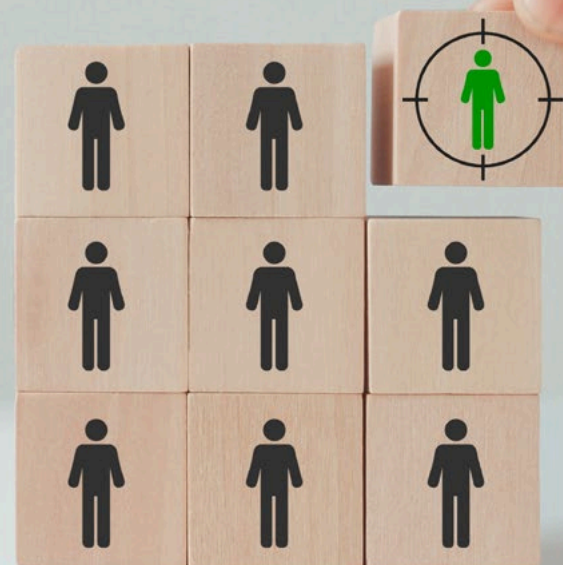
